#### STAY INFORMED. **GET INVOLVED**

A number of exciting ministry opportunities are In the planning stage:

► Millvale Mayor Brian Spoles and the **Triboro Ecodistrict** have approached CLC to explore the possibility of placing a playground on the property adjacent to our building. There is no playground at our end of Millvale and there is a need to provide a play area for the children of Millvale. All costs will be covered by the Triboro Ecodistrict.

CLC will have input on the design and size of the playground. Pastor Scott and Paul Bell met initially with the Mayor and the Congregational Council is looking forward to further conversations.

► Millvale is a food desert, meaning there is no grocery store within borough boundaries. In addition, the bus route that carried people to Shop 'n Save was discontinued, so people do not have easy access to food.

Farm-to-Table has approached CLC to partner with us in providing a number of services to those in need.

Can CLC become a food drop site for 412 Food Rescue? They "rescue" food from restaurants and grocery stores, bring it to CLC, and we would notify people in Millvale through social media of its availability.

- "Cooking Matters" classes for parents about healthy food preparation, food preservation, and wise shopping.
- A Cooking Club for seniors providing both healthy recipes and monthly fellowship.
- Exploring whether Millvale needs a second Summer Lunch Program site.
- Re-visiting a former plan to expand Neighborhood Table to a second night, aimed at parents and children.
- A coordinated effort to serve the homeless.
   Pastor Scott has written a grant to the Verney Fund of the SWPA Synod to provide monies for a coordinator to oversee these food ministries.
- ▶ Pat Milliken is heading up our efforts to transform our green space into a more environmentally friendly area for pollinators and cultivators. We want to be a leader among congregations in ensuring we can do whatever we can to contribute to the health of our ecosystem. As Easter approaches, watch for how you can contribute to this effort.
- ► We have contracted with Chef Scott Baker (Square One Catering) to use our kitchen to prep for his larger catering events. In exchange, Chef Baker will provide continued on next page >

his services free of charge for these four events each year:

- Fat Tuesday
- CLC Youth Work Camp Dinner
- Millvale Community Carnival
- Rally Day

#### **MOVING ON MINISTRY TEAMS**


